

CODICIL TO LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

This is a codicil to my Last Will and Testament dated _____.
Wherever there is a conflict between the provisions of this codicil and the provisions of my will, the provisions of this codicil shall control.

The Old Testament of the Holy Bible contains the accounts of two individuals who disappeared “mysteriously” as a result of being taken directly to Heaven by God. There was no physical body left on earth. In Genesis 5: 21-24, the Scripture says “and Enoch walked with God and was not, for God took him.” Also in Hebrews 11:5 in the New Testament, it says that “By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death, and was not found, because God had translated him”

In addition, in II Kings 2:11, there is an account of Elijah being taken up bodily to Heaven in a whirlwind.

As a result of these Old Testament “pictures” and as a result of the teaching of the New Testament found in I Thessalonians Chapter 4 and I Corinthians Chapter 15, it is my firm belief that there is a snatching away of Christians by the Lord Jesus Christ, with the result that there will be a sudden disappearance of millions of people without any physical bodies being left. The Bible says this could happen at any time.

If I should “disappear” in this manner, I direct that I be declared legally dead and the remaining provisions of this codicil put into immediate effect.

I give _____ % of my entire estate, after payment of debts, taxes and fees, to my family members who did not disappear at the time of the above-described event. This percentage is to be divided among them by my executor as follows:

All the rest and the remainder of my estate, being _____ %, I give to Honey Rock End Time Foundation to be administered by them for their stated purposes, without any further direction or control by this codicil.

In the event of the above-described occurrence, I name Honey Rock End Time Foundation as executor of my estate without bond.

Should my executor, in his sole discretion, consider it advantageous to do so, he may serve in the capacity of an Independent Executor and administer the estate under the provisions for Independent Administration of estate as provided by Louisiana Code of Civil Procedure.
