

Rapture Clause

Rough Draft of language to be included in Last Will and Testament

The Old Testament of the Holy Bible contains the accounts of two individuals who disappeared “mysteriously” as a result of being taken directly to Heaven by God. There was no physical body left on Earth. In Genesis 5:21-24, the Scriptures says “That Enoch walked with God but was not, for God took him.” Also in Hebrews 11:5 in the New Testament, it says that “Enoch was not found for God translated him.”

In addition, in II Kings 2:11 there is an account of Elijah being taken up to Heaven in a whirlwind.

As a result of these Old Testament “pictures” and as a result of the teaching of the New Testament found in I Thessalonians Chapter 4 and I Corinthians Chapter 15, it is my firm belief that there will be a snatching away of Christians by the Lord Jesus Christ, with the result that there will be a sudden disappearance of millions of people without any physical bodies being left.
